Have you ever tried to get Windows Notepad to use the duplexing or stapling capabilities of a printer? Notepad, and many other basic utilities, fail to utilize the resources of your printers. Even when it looks as if the application can access a capability found on the printer, the output fails to use the feature. PAN makes the most undisciplined applications toe the line; generating output that employs the printer features in which you have invested.

No more hassling with filters

Unix system administrators are familiar with the need to create filters on queues to achieve a particular result. PAN's unique approach ends this need to program filters by allowing administrators to create collections of printer features, such as stapling, tray selection, duplexing, etc. which can be assigned a name that users can select with a simple click in a drop-down menu.

End contention from multiple print queues

The heterogeneous nature of today's enterprise computing environment leads to multiple computers and operating systems contending for the same printing resources, each using its own print queue. By centralizing queue management within PAN, all printing activity, no matter

where its origin, is visible. By creating a network operating system for printing, PAN gives all platforms and users a uniform, centralized environment for control and visibility of all printing activities.

Consolidate queues for all platforms

In addition to providing single queues for all of the systems in a network, PAN allows the creation of "forms" to simplify the task of administering your network's printing capabilities. Many administrators create multiple queues attempting to manage the abilities of their printers. With PAN, for example, instead of creating a queue for duplexing and another queue for stapling on the same printer, duplicating this work for each system in the network, a single PAN "form" can be created that will behave identically across all printers in the network. A single queue for each printer accomplishes what required many queues before. Furthermore, the power of forms is such that even though specific printers require different printer commands to invoke the same feature, a form will work regardless of where a job is originally sent, and where it ultimately ends up printing.

Downsize your printing hardware needs

Printer queues in PAN reside in "print areas", which are themselves print queues. Print jobs submitted to an area queue are candidates for printing on any queue within the area which has the required capabilities of the job. A job requiring duplexing will not be sent to a printer without duplexing capabilities. PAN saves you money by making the best use of the resources you have purchased.


Empower your help desk

PAN's browser-based interface provides help desk personnel with powerful tools to monitor and control printing. Dynamic queue displays provide visibility of queue activity in a single glance.

Other tools provide the ability to reassign jobs to queues, and to monitor individual printer performance. When a printer error occurs, such as a paper jam, it's clearly visible through queue status displays. Furthermore, queue states can be controlled to allow or disallow both the inflow and outflow of print jobs.

Manage all network printing from one place

Different operating systems require different methods of levels of support for complex printing requirements.



Paper jam or printer troubles? Move your print job to another queue with a click of the mouse.

This requires redundant effort on the

part of the administrator, and even then the result will be varying degrees of success. By consolidating printing for all platforms under PAN, you will always get the desired results without sacrificing any level of functionality.


